Re: Standby Trust Agreement (“Agreement”) dated March 15, 2012 by and between Cardinal Health 414, LLC (“Grantor”) and JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association (“Trustee”).

As you know, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission required Grantor to provide assurance that funds would be available for required decommissioning activities at Grantor’s facility located at 131 East Hartland St., East Hartford, CT 06108 and 10718 Trenton Ave. St Louis, MS 63132. Grantor elected to use a surety bond of such financial assurance and created a standby trust to be used for receipt of such payment.

The Trustee has provided notice of resignation under the Agreement. Grantor has appointed U.S. Bank National Association (“Successor Trustee”) to serve as successor Trustee under the Agreement. This is to serve as notice that the Successor Trustee will assume administration of the standby trust effective February 20, 2017.
