Specifically, since the last inspection on December 15-19, 2011, the licensee had only performed three annual program audits over five calendar years (12/28/2012, 03/06/2014, 01/06/2016). Annual audits were also required in calendar years 2013 and 2015.  This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Manual 8.3.d.3.).  Correction actions were completed and included the RSO implementing a calendar reminder to perform an annual audit in each calendar year.
