Gentlemen:

By letter dated October 20, 1977, you submitted for Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, Unit No. 1, a request for an exemption from the search and access control requirements of Section 73.55 (d) (1) to provide guard access to the construction area through a temporary man-gate. We have reviewed this request and based on the compensatory measures proposed we have determined that the exemption may be granted because it does not decrease the protection afforded to the facility, is authorized by law, and will not endanger life or property or the common defense and security, and is otherwise in the public interest.

An evaluation of the request is on file in this office, but is being withheld from public disclosure under provisions of 10 CFR 2.790.
