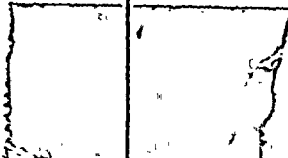

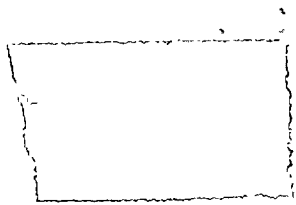



Gentlemen:

Our letter of July 2, 1974 indicated that we planned to have a Containment Atmospheric Dilution System operable by the end of 1976. However, due to a change to an 18 month refueling schedule and longer than anticipated equipment lead time, the system cannot be operational until September 30, 1977. In the interim, capability for nitrogen addition and manual venting will be maintained.
