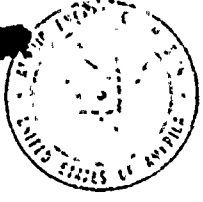


Dear Mr. Carlson:

We have reviewed the subject report and find no proprietary information which would necessitate petitioning a separation from this document under the rules of Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Code of Federal Regulation.

We find one statement in the report which we feel is either misstated or misleading as stated. In the section titled "Details", paragraph 3-C, it is stated; "No design review meetings have yet been held in accordance with PSAR section R-D.7 and Project Procedure No. 7". Since design review meetings have been held and we have documentary evidence of the same, we feel it would be more accurate to state; "Design review meetings have been held but no systems have completed the design review cycle in accordance with PSAR section R-D.7 and Project Procedure No. 7". We request that you make an appropriate change in the final report.
