Gentlemen:

In our letter dated October 1, 1973, we requested that you inspect Bergen-Paterson snubbers outside containment in the Nine Mile Point Unit No. 1 reactor every 30 days and report the results to us within 15 days after the inspection. In a letter dated March 6, 1974, you proposed to continue the inspections as requested, but only submit positive reports when defective units are found. These reports would be written within 10 days. If all units were found to be satisfactory, you proposed that no report would be written.

We have reviewed your proposal and find it satisfactory. Since you have inspected your Bergen-Paterson snubbers for several months and have not observed any defective units, elimination of negative reports will reduce unnecessary paperwork. However, the inspection results should be maintained and be available for inspection by Regulatory Operations should the detailed information be needed.

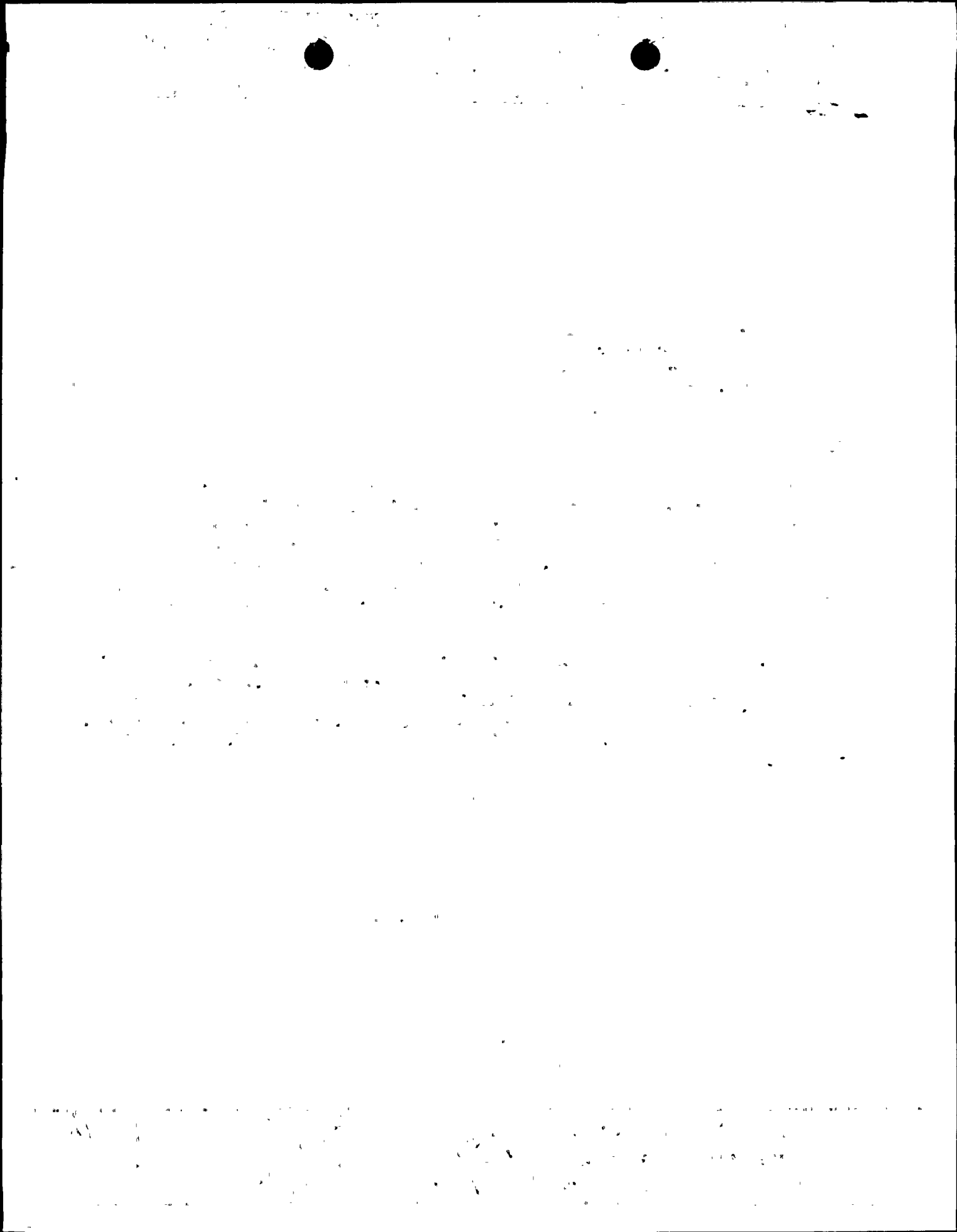
