INFORMATION CONCERNING APPLICATION FOR A NEW LICENSE

Dear Mr. An:

This letter refers to your application dated January 6, 2017 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML17037D300), and received by our office on February 3, 2017, for a new U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Exempt Distribution Materials License. In reviewing your application, we have determined additional information is required to complete our review. In order to continue our review, please address the issues listed below. This information is required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 40.52, "Certain items containing source material; requirements for license to apply or initially transfer."

1. 10 CFR 40.52(b)(4) requires the applicant submits the the proposed method of labeling or marking each unit, and/or its container with the identification of the initial transferor of the product and the source material in the product. Please provide a sample label of your product.
2. 10 CFR 40.52(b)(5) requires the applicant to have a means of providing radiation safety precautions and instructions relating to handling, use, and storage of products to be used under 10 CFR 40.13(c)(1)(i) and (c)(1)(iii). Please provide the means you will meet the above requirement.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your application.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390 (b)(1).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records component of NRC's ADAMS. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
