RULES OF PROCEDURE

General Comment

Dear NRC-

I am very disturbed by the prospect of Texas serving as a repository (interim or otherwise) for spent nuclear reactor fuel rods from other states. Our state should not be considered a dumping ground for California, or anywhere else. This is dangerous material and the proposed site was created for low level waste - not spent fuel rods. It is not at all clear how long this dangerous material would remain at this site, 30 years, 40 years, longer?. The potential for accidents during transport across the state is also very concerning to me. The risk of contamination of our aquifers, our land, and the public health danger this represents is to me unacceptable. I believe that states that generated the waste should find a local solution and not export such dangerous material.
