Subject: Your 2.206 petition dated January 24, 2017 on forgings: immediate actions

Dear Mr. Gunter:

On January 24, 2017, you submitted on behalf of “Beyond Nuclear and co-petitioners” a Petition for Emergency Enforcement Action per 10 CFR 2.206 at U.S. Reactors with Forged Components and Parts Manufactured at France’s AREVA-Le Creusot Forge and Japan Casting and Forging Corporation (hereafter, referred to as the petition). The petition, in part, requested immediate suspension of reactor operations at the listed reactors, pending inspections and material testing of installed components identified with the manufactured irregularities and anomalies described in the petition. In accordance with Management Directive (MD), “Review Process for 10 CFR 2.206 Petitions,” the Petition Review Board (PRB) met to consider the immediate aspects of the request. The MD further states that the petitioner will be notified promptly of staff decisions on any immediate action requests. This is to inform you that the PRB determined that the immediate action requested is not warranted at this time because it has reasonable assurance of public health and safety and protection of the environment.
