Information Needed for Transfer of Control and/or Ownership

1. PharmOptima, current NRC license No. 21-32649-01 located in Portage, Michigan will transfer its existing license to Genesis PharmOptima, LLC as a result of a purchase of PharmOptima's assets. The license will remain in its current physical location in Portage, Michigan. No changes are proposed with regards to location, equipment, and procedures.
  2. Douglas Decker will remain as the Radiation Safety Officer. Any new personnel will be trained in the safe handling of radioactive material and will be under the supervision of the Radiation Safety Officer. Site Management will also remain the same.
  3. No changes are proposed with regards to location, equipment, and procedures.
  4. No changes are proposed for surveillance records. All surveillance items (surveys and wipe tests) records will continue to be current at the time of transfer. Records are kept with respect to radioactive materials ordered and current inventory and disposal.
  5. At this time, there are no plans for the decommissioning of the facility. If in the future, a decision is made to decommission the site, all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to the NRC, as appropriate.
  6. Genesis PharmOptima, LLC as the transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, and commitments of the transferor.
