

Your April 17, 1979 I. E. Bulletin 79-09 requested Niagara Mohawk to determine if General Electric type AK-2 circuit breakers are planned for use in safety-related systems at Nine Mile Point Unit 2. We do not plan to use General Electric type AK-2 circuit breakers in safety-related systems at Unit 2. The safety-related equipment which would utilize this type of circuit breaker has been purchased and it has been verified that the subject circuit breakers are not compatible with our equipment.
