Thank you for your letter dated August 25, 1979 concerning the efforts of Massena, New York to obtain transmission services from Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation.

We have been following this situation as it has developed. Under applicable NRC antitrust review procedures, the next opportunity for an antitrust review of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation will occur in mid-1981 when the company files an application for an operating license for the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station, Unit 2. A copy of your letter will be retained in our files and we will be in contact with you when the application is received and we start our operating license antitrust review. Additionally, we are providing a copy of your letter together with this response to the attorney following this matter in the Antitrust Division of the Department of Justice.
