Your November 6, 1980 Inspection and Enforcement Bulletin 80-21 requested actions regarding valve yokes supplied by Malcolm Foundry Co., Inc.

A survey of valve manufacturers is being conducted to determine if valve parts at Nine Mile Point Unit 1 were cast by Malcolm Foundry Company. Preliminary results of our survey to date indicate that parts cast by Malcolm Foundry Company were not used in valves at Nine Mile Point Unit 1. Niagara Mohawk will complete its survey of valve manufacturers and provide the final results along with any schedule for future inspections by January 15, 1981.

Approximately six man-weeks will be required to conduct the review of valve manufacturers and obtain the required documentation. If future inspections are required, additional manpower will be needed.
