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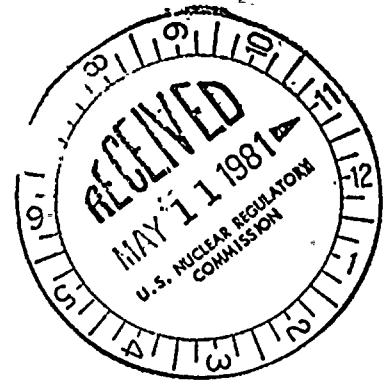

Your letter of April 6, 1981 denied Niagara Mohawk's request for an exemption from two sections of 10CFR73.55. This exemption was requested to accommodate construction of a new Radwaste Building on the east side of the existing facility.
