Dear Mr. Brunner:

Our letter of November 28, 1978 indicated that by December 31, 1980 all Nine Mile Point Unit 1 detailed design records generated since the issuance of the permanent operating license would be stored in accordance with ANSI N.45.2.9. As outlined below, additional time will be required to meet this requirement.

Since November 1978, Niagara Mohawk has maintained a staff of personnel dedicated to meeting the storage requirement criteria. However, it appears Niagara Mohawk underestimated both the volume of material to be stored and the manhour requirements. Additionally, since November 1978, a substantial and unexpected number of new documents have been generated. The volume of newly generated material is not expected to decrease in the near future.

Based on the current backlog, an additional two years will be required to be in full compliance with ANSI N.45.2.9 for documents generated since the issuance of the permanent operating license.
