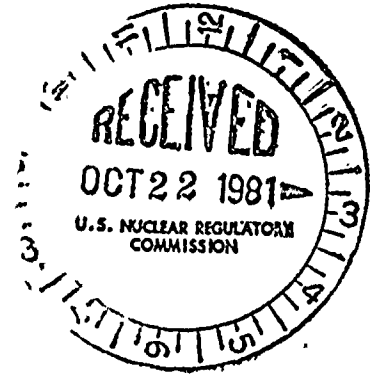

Our letter of June 30, 1981 stated that the Prompt Notification System required by Section IV.D.3 of Appendix E to 10 CFR 50 was scheduled for completion and verification testing by the end of October, 1981. However, as a result of equipment delivery delays and inclement weather, the as designed system will not be completely tested and operational until December 31, 1981. Additionally, results of system testing may indicate that additional sirens and/or tone alert radios, not anticipated in the design, may have to be placed. Installation of additional equipment may extend until February 1, 1982.
