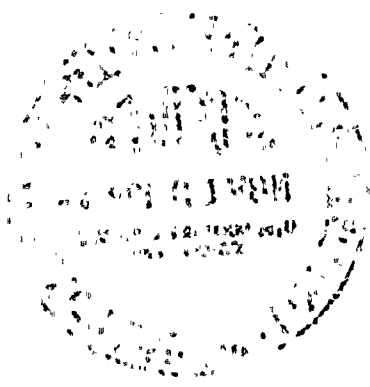

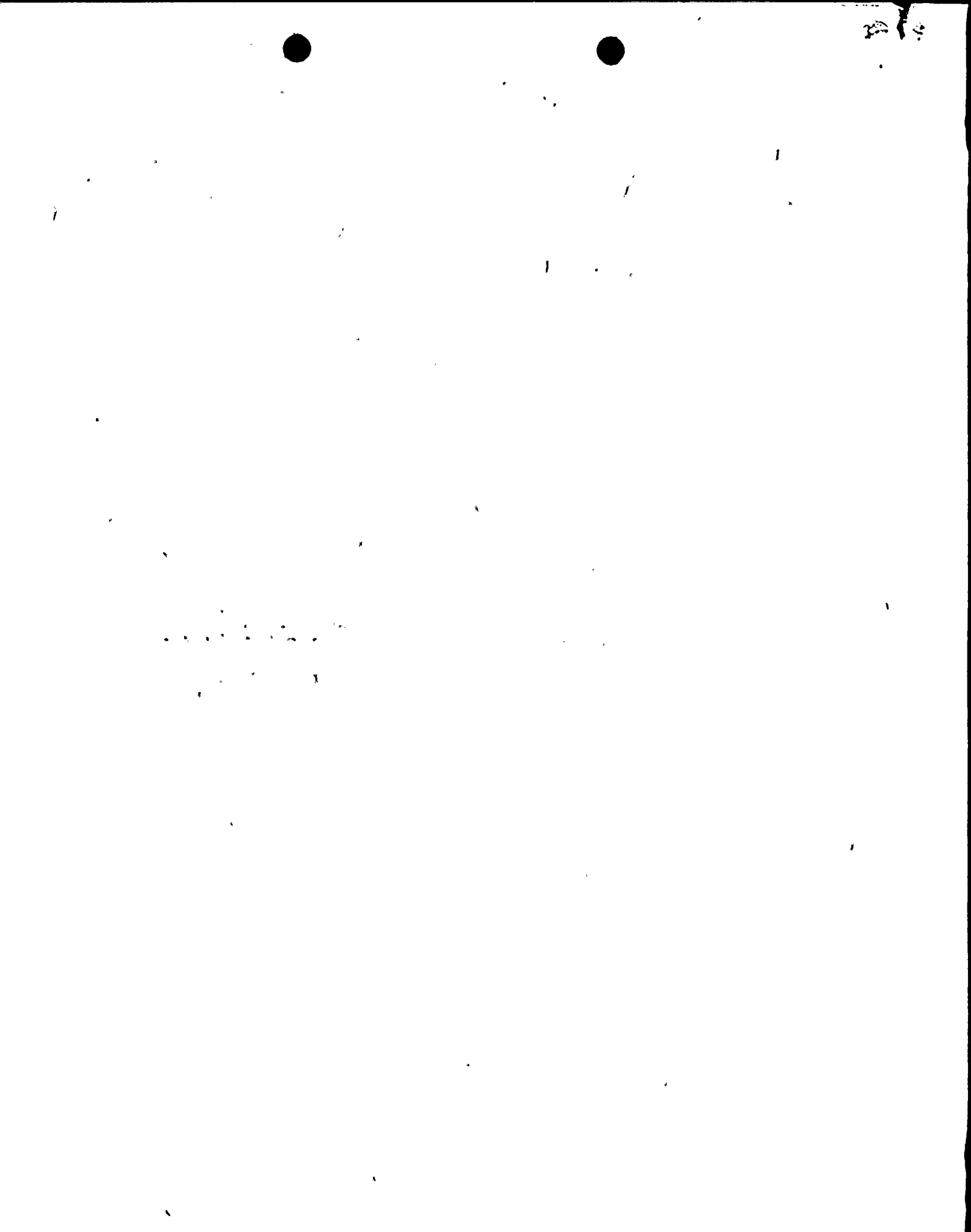

GENERAL ANNOUNCEMENT

As approved by the Gibbs & Hill Board of Directors on October 30, 1981, certain organizational changes are being implemented to improve pursuit of new work in our principal market, the power industry; penetrate other markets; and increase our ability to compete by undertaking a wider range of project scope in all our markets. The changes will also facilitate more effective communication amongst our senior management and our day-to-day operating officers.

More specifically, these changes will:

- o place under a senior officer the management of all domestic and international business-getting activities, thereby improving the cohesiveness of these activities among New York, the Regional Offices, DUCI, DVH, our overseas affiliates, and other units of Dravo Engineers and Constructors, when involved;
- o consolidate all New York project and engineering activities (except for certain specialized functions) under a single senior officer;
- o weld further the joint endeavors of G&H and DUCI in their pursuit of engineering-procurement-construction project assignments, and maximize profit on other joint activities;
- o concentrate management control of our Southern and Western Regional Offices under unified leadership to accelerate market development in those regions and foster the rapid growth of these offices;
- o enhance our overall operations in the Mid-Western Regional Office, by placing G&H and DUCI activities conducted from that office under a single senior officer;



- o direct the activities of the GIBSIN president and the GHESA managing director (our two overseas affiliates) on those opportunities that they pursue for G&H, recognizing that their normal reporting chain is directly to the board of directors of each of those companies for non-Gibbs & Hill business;
- o combine the efforts of DVH and DUCI to mutually strengthen their marketing capabilities.
