Our letter of June 7, 1982 presented a plan and schedule for upgrading the Nine Mile Point Unit 1 Emergency Support Facilities. At that time, a completion date of October 1, 1982 was indicated for all modifications. However, due to problems encountered during system testing, not all of the modifications have been completed. A list of the modifications and a revised schedule for completion is presented below:


ALTERNATE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS FACILITY (AEOF) TRANSFER

While Niagara Mohawk's intent was to have the Emergency Support Facilities operational by October 1, 1982, problems arose during pre-operational testing. These problems will be resolved by January 1, 1983. The only exception to this is the installation and operation of our meteorological tower, which will be accomplished by March 1, 1983 (as previously stated in our August 20, 1982 letter). In the interim, Niagara Mohawk will continue to follow the current revision of the Nine Mile Point Site Emergency Plan.
