Our letter of December 22, 1982 provided clarification of our fire brigade initial qualification and subsequent annual requalification tests. A typographical error resulted in the partial deletion of one sentence. Provided below is the same information with the correction incorporated. This letter supersedes our previous letter of December 22, 1982.

During a Nuclear Regulatory Commission inspection (50-220/82-09) conducted at Nine Mile Point Unit 1 on June 15-18, 1982, we informed members of your staff that our planned initial qualification test for fire brigade members and subsequent annual requalification test would include the same physical examination and agility test. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of a change to our testing methods. The initial hiring of a prospective employee is based upon passing all of the following:

1. Aptitude test.
2. Physical examination by a doctor, in accordance with NFPA 1001.
3. Firefighters Fitness Test - NFPA 1001.

Requalification, as a fireman, is required on an annual basis. The requalification program consists of the following:

1. Physical examination, by a doctor, in accordance with NFPA 1001.
2. Guard Physical Fitness, Qualification Test.

The Guard Physical Fitness, Qualification Test is the same test as the security personnel at Niagara Mohawk are required to take. We believe that this annual requalification agility test is sufficient to indicate that a fireman has maintained adequate fitness to perform strenuous work.
