Dear Mr. Vassallo:

Our letter of April 15, 1983 provided various schedules related to Supplement 1 to NUREG-0737. Included within those schedules were anticipated starting dates for training related to the new symptom oriented Emergency Operating Procedures. It was anticipated at that time that training would commence by December 1, 1984. It was further indicated that time delays in the schedule could occur as a result of the construction schedule for the Nine Mile Point Unit 1 plant specific simulator as well as final preparation of the plant specific Emergency Operating Procedures.

Our current schedule calls for completion of the initial draft of the Emergency Operating Procedures by January 31, 1985. Formal training on these procedures will commence shortly after appropriate review and approval of these procedures.

The original anticipated implementation date for the Emergency Operating Procedures was following the 1986 refueling outage. The new schedule for completion of the Emergency Operating Procedures is not anticipated to adversely affect our original schedule for implementation.
