Dear Mr. Keppler:

Reference (a) transmitted a revised schedule for the installation of fire suppression systems in the Dresden Station cable spreading room. The schedule stated a completion date of December 1978 which was dependent on vendor stated equipment delivery dates.

Due to delays in equipment deliveries, primarily the Halon system manifold, this date could not be met. Since all material has not yet been received and vendor projected delivery dates have not been reliable, it is impossible to specify a new completion date at this time. Deliveries are anticipated to take place early in February 1979. It is expected that installation and testing could be completed and the system made operational six weeks after final equipment delivery. We will inform you when material deliveries are complete and provide you with a firm installation completion date at that time.
