WasteChem Corporation hereby submits its Topical Report entitled "10CFR61 Waste Form Conformance Program for Solidified Process Waste Products Produced by a WasteChem Corporation Volume Reduction and Solidification (VRS) System." The report is intended to assist the NRC and the States in assuring that the described wastes meet the applicable requirements of 10CFR61.

WasteChem requests the NRC's formal review of this Topical Report. Fifteen copies of the report are enclosed. The format follows the NRC's "Procedure for Review of Topical Reports on Solidification Agents, High Integrity Containers and Computer Codes on Waste Classification."

The results of the long-term biodegradation tests are not yet included in the report. In accordance with an agreement reached with NRC staff members, these data will be submitted as a supplement to the report as soon as WasteChem has completed compilation and analysis. We expect this supplement to be submitted within three weeks.

This report is considered proprietary. An affidavit to justify the proprietary status is enclosed.
