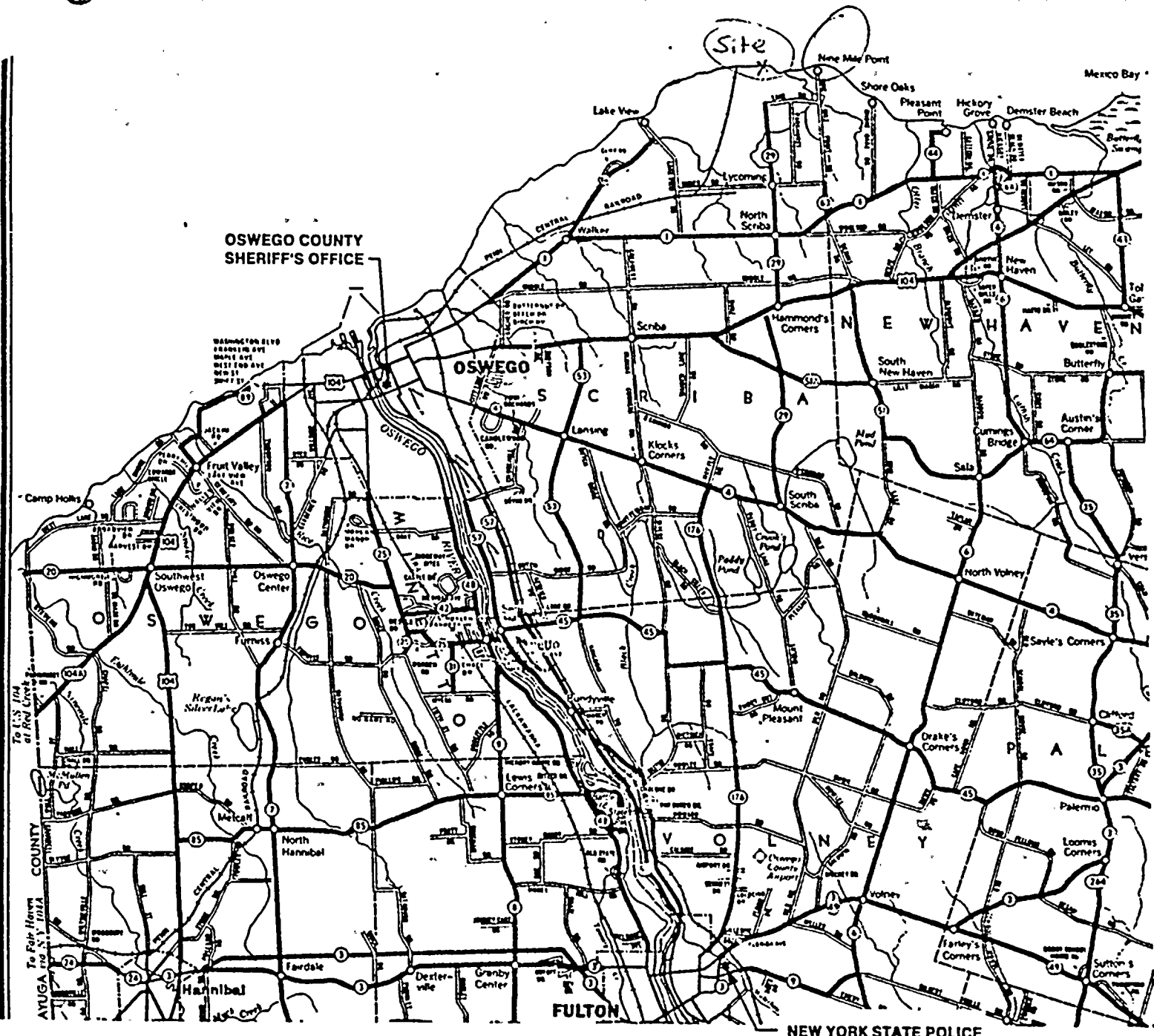
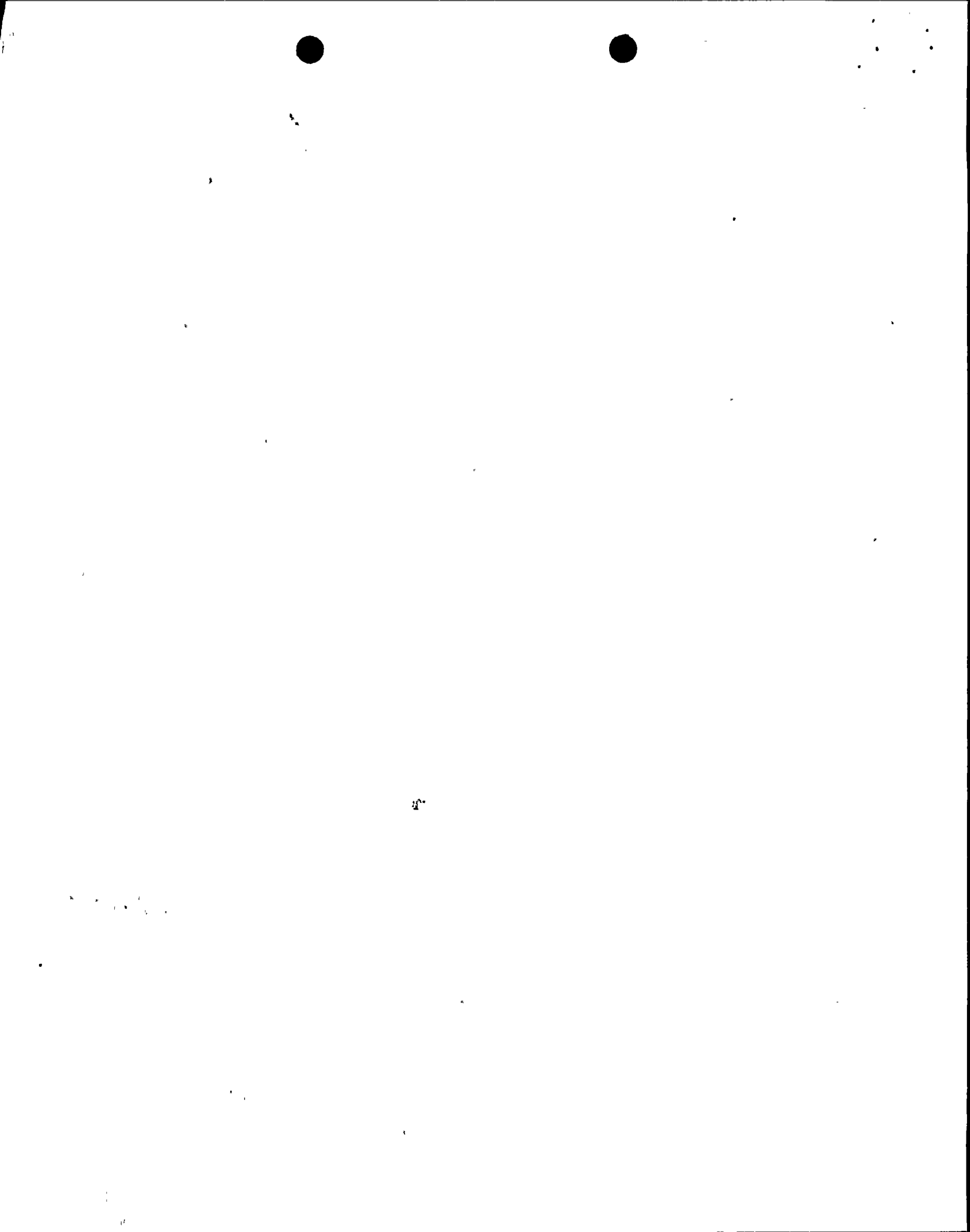
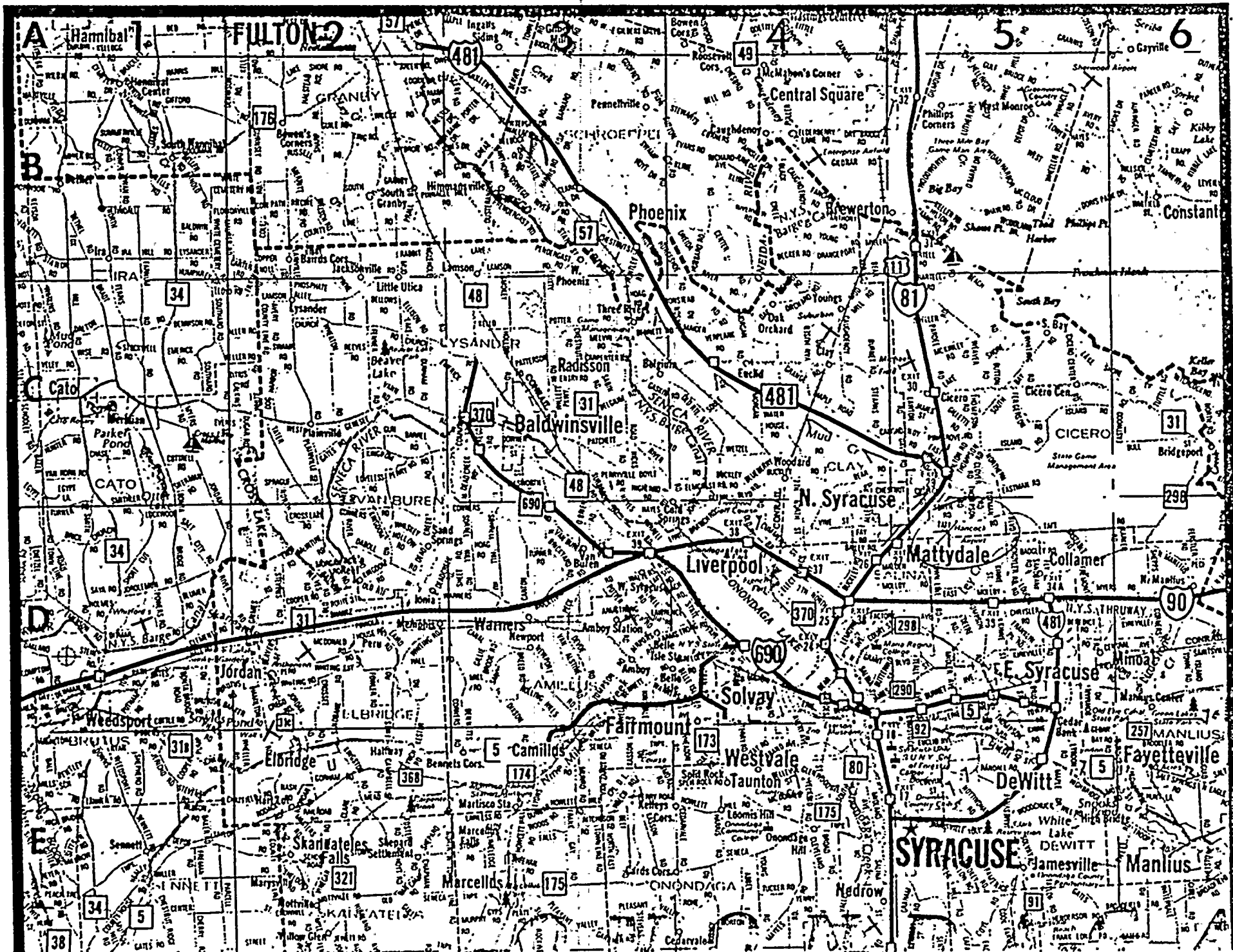
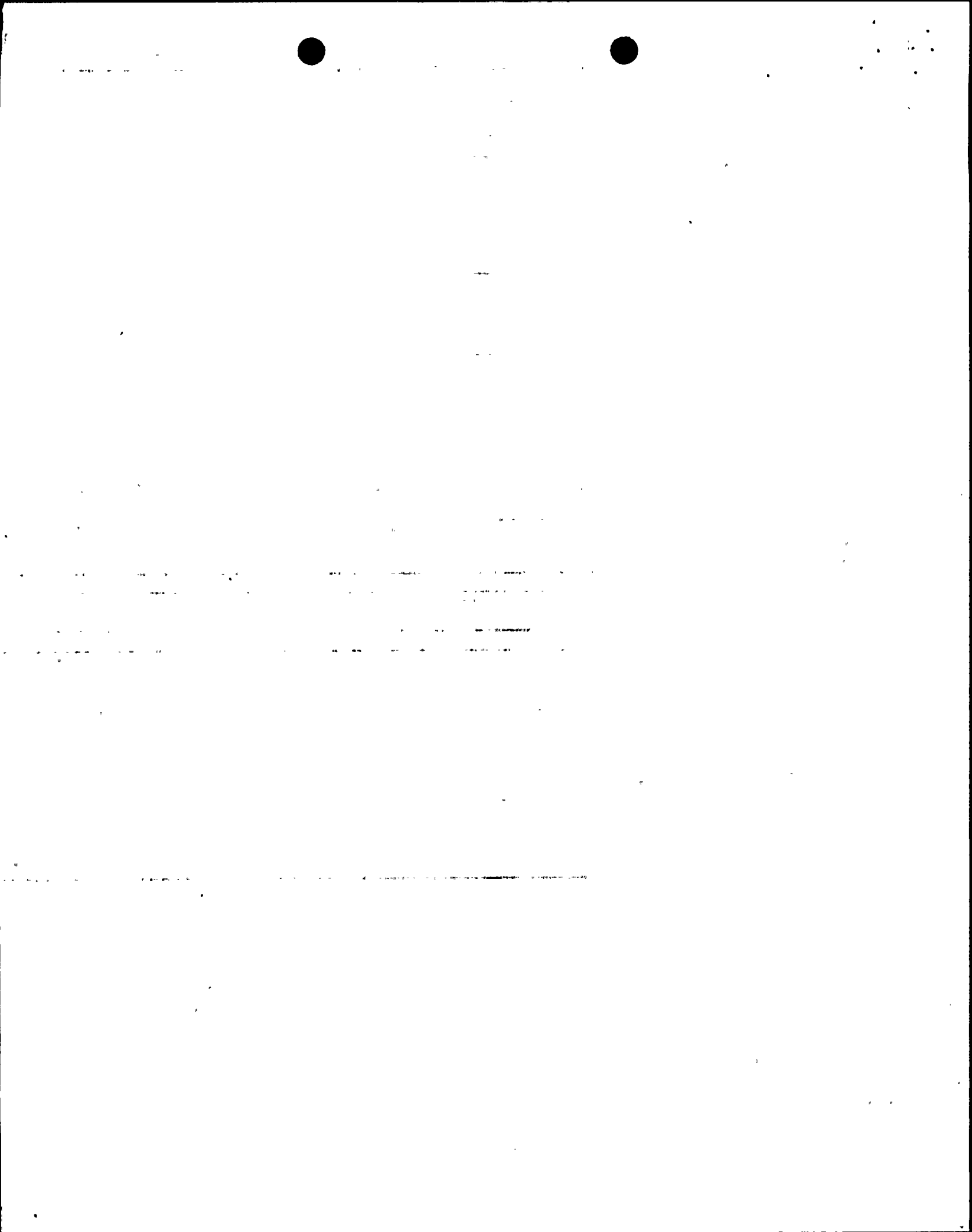


FIGURE 3

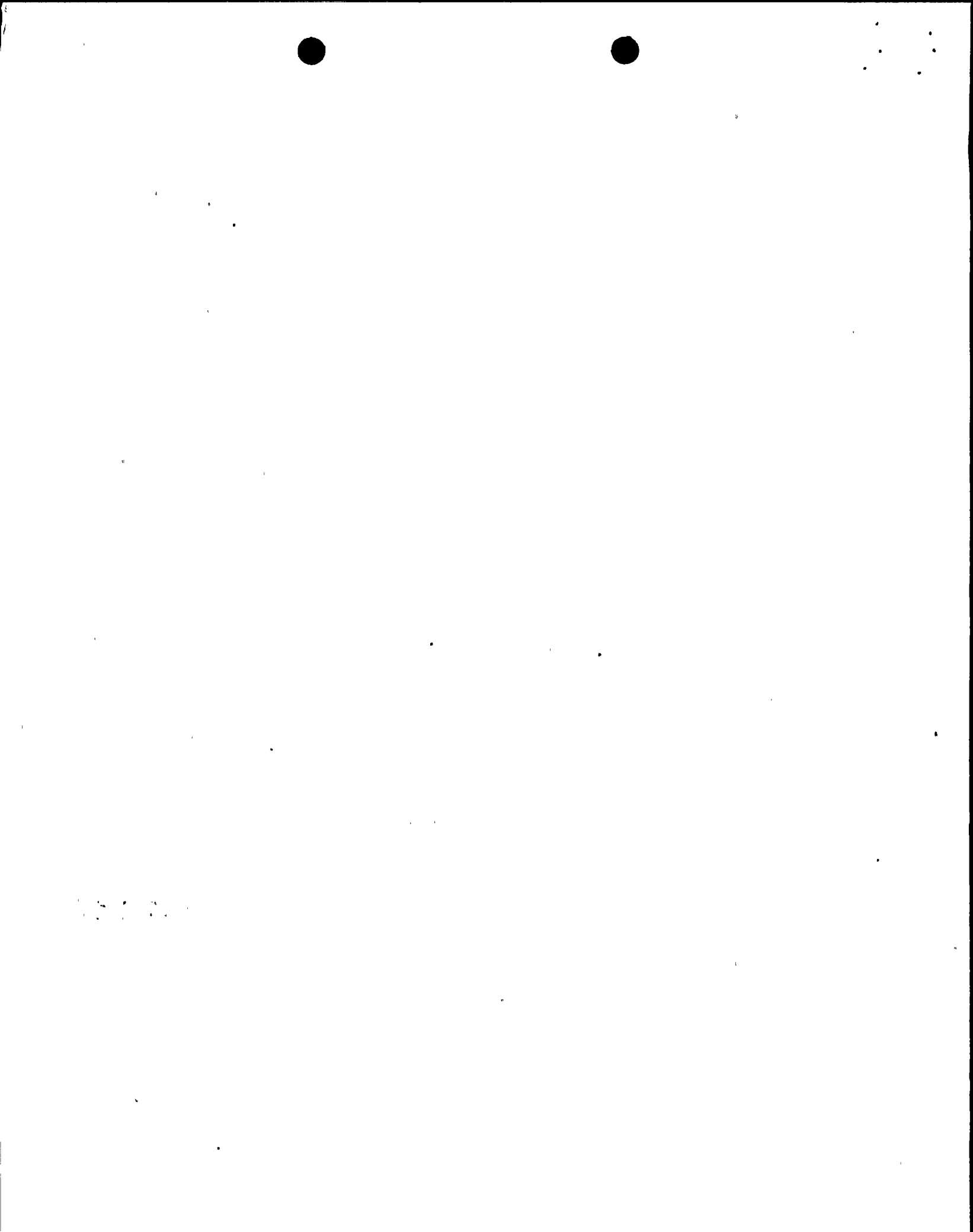

Make right on RT. 104 (Bridge Street) just before Holiday Harbor Hotel
(small Niagara Mohawk office on corner)

Go about 3 miles (pass McDonalds on right, Burger King on left)

Make the first left past the Chevy dealer (follow sign to NMP information center)

Go to second stop sign, make right continue to follow signs to the NMP information center making a left turn just before the plant (NMP-2 has a cooling tower so plant site is obvious). The training center is located in back of the information center.

Make 2 lefts into Fulton Motor Lodge parking lot.

Make a left on 481 (at Holiday Harbor)

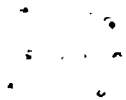
