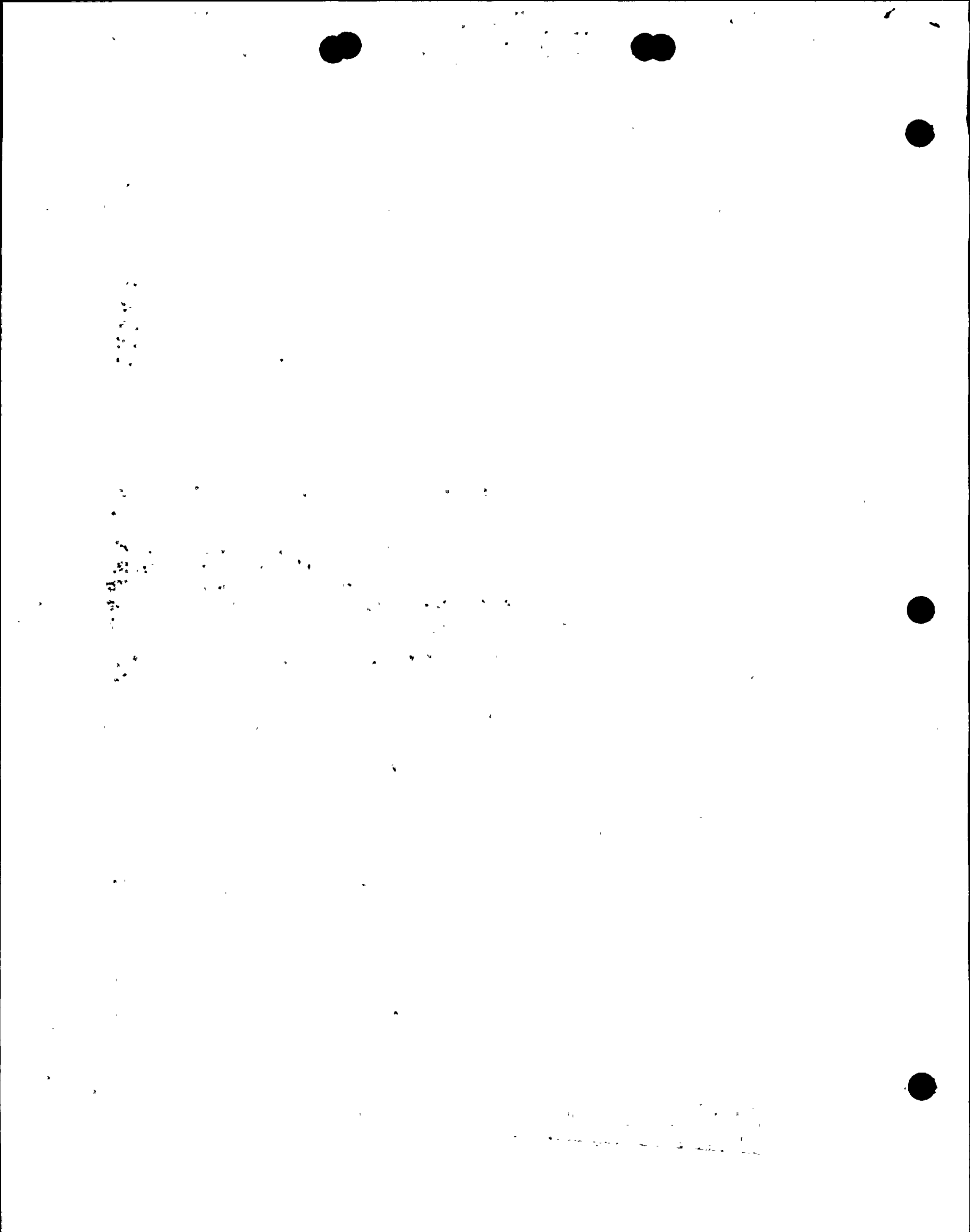
Attached is Revision 2 of the Quality Assurance Topical Report NMPC-QATR-1 for Nine Mile Point Unit 2. This revision incorporates the changes to the Quality Assurance Program since the Topical Report was approved by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in December 1985. These changes are being submitted in accordance with the requirements of 10CFR50.54(a)(3). The changes are noted by vertical markings in the right-hand margin and are summarized below. Changes can be classified as revisions to reflect current organization titles and responsibilities, additions to describe responsibilities of organizations not previously included and clarifications to more precisely define commitments with no change of intent. The changes are:

Section 1 was updated to reflect changes in position titles and responsibilities of various organizational units. Paragraphs were added to describe responsibilities of the Manager of Nuclear Technology and Superintendent, Nuclear Construction. The title "Director, Quality Assurance" was changed throughout to read "Vice President, Quality Assurance".

Paragraphs 1.2.4.B.6; B.7 and B.8 were revised to show reassignment of responsibility for representation on the Site Operations Review Committee (SORC) to the QA Program Manager.

Paragraph 1.2.4.B.8 was revised to remove the requirement for Surveillance of Security in recognition of the Unit 1 and 2 Technical Specification requirement for Audit of Security by the Safety Review and Audit Board (SRAB), the Offsite Review Committee and the concern for proper handling of safeguards information.

Paragraph 3.2.8 was revised to indicate that all Modification Design Packages are subject to audit by Quality Assurance.

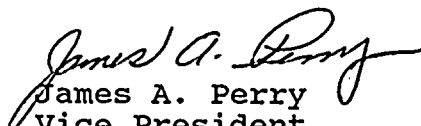
Paragraph 5.2.3 was revised to more clearly define the content of procedures.

Appendix B, Paragraph 4.e was added to describe file containers used for temporary storage of QA Records prior to processing into the Plant Permanent File. There has been no change to the commitment for permanent record storage facilities.

The changes have been evaluated and determined not to reduce commitments.
