A routine safety inspection of your annual emergency preparedness exercise was conducted by Mr. C. Gordon and other members of an NRC team on August 1-3, 1988 at the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Power Station, Scriba, New York. Discussions of our findings were presented by Mr. Gordon to Mr. Willis and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection included observation of the annual exercise and follow-up of findings identified during previous emergency preparedness inspections and exercises as described in the NRC Region I inspection report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel and observation of the emergency exercise by team members.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations were identified. Niagara Mohawk's performance during the exercise demonstrated the ability to implement the Emergency Plan and Emergency Plan Implementing Procedures in a manner that would provide adequate protective measures for the health and safety of the public.

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
