By letters dated September 25, 1990, and May 15, 1991, Niagara Mohawk responded to Generic Letter 90-03 and indicated that two enhancements to our vendor interface program are required to fully comply with the elements of the generic letter. Our letter of May 15, 1991 also stated that these program enhancements would be developed and implemented by December 31, 1991. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the enhancements were completed by December 31, 1991 as scheduled and to briefly discuss them.

The first enhancement involved strengthening the interface with our NSSS vendor, General Electric, to assure that technical information provided for safety-related NSSS equipment is received by Niagara Mohawk. A process was developed and incorporated into Nuclear Procurement Administrative Procedure NPAP-INV-270 for assuring the receipt of technical information from General Electric. The procedure identifies the document types of interest and provides a mechanism for tracking correspondence to and from General Electric and the Nuclear Division department responsible for evaluating a particular document type. General Electric will be contacted annually for each Unit to assure that all relevant technical information has been obtained.



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The second area that required enhancement was our interface with non-NSSS vendors of other key safety-related equipment. As outlined in our May 15, 1991 letter, the equipment and vendors to be included in the non-NSSS scope of our vendor interface program were identified for each Unit based on a screening process consistent with the guidance provided in the Generic Letter. Nuclear Procurement Administrative Procedure No. NPAP-INV-270 identifies the non-NSSS vendors to be contacted for each Unit. The process for ensuring receipt of technical information is the same as for the NSSS vendor, except it is performed on an alternating year basis for each Unit.

Based on the implementation of the above enhancements to the vendor interface program, Niagara Mohawk's program, as described in our May 15, 1991 letter, complies with the elements of Generic Letter 90-03.


