Dear Dr. Rozear,

This refers to your request dated December 8, 2016, to amend your license to reduce the holding time for cats meeting the dose rate criteria of 0.5 mrem/hr at one meter. In order to continue our review of your request, the following additional information is needed:

It is my understanding from my phone conversation with you on January 12, 2017, that your intention was to request release of cats that have been administered I-131 with a remaining activity measuring radiation levels $<0.5\text{mrem/hr}$ at one meter and only after 48 hours post injection. If this is correct, please re-submit your request and provide the following supporting information:

1. The criteria that will be used to support release under these conditions. For instance, your original letter indicated that veterinary research has shown certain biological retention times in cats. Please provide a copy of this research.
2. Submit the written procedure used for determining when each cat may be released and describe the steps in this procedure.
3. Submit the calculation used to show the dose that will be remaining in each cat at the time of release and confirm that each calculation will be reviewed to ensure compliance with public dose limits prior to each cat's release. Confirm that copies of each cat's release calculation will be retained for inspection.
4. The written instructions provided to the owner.
5. Any other applicable information.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email; or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your amendment.
