Dear Mr. Bell:

The NRC issued an Order (ML16278A618) on October 20, 2016 revoking your license within 20 days based on nonpayment of license fees. The Order was reissued on December 9, 2016 (ML16343A119). You failed to pay the debt owed to the NRC (\$21,200.00) and your license was revoked on January 19, 2017. Since your license was revoked, the license renewal application dated August 29, 2016 submitted to the NRC (Control No. 591802) was voided and no further action will be taken.

Be advised that in the future, should you decide to resume operations after revocation of your license, you will be required to pay all debts to the NRC and apply for and be issued a new license, which also requires payment of an application fee.
