Subject: Correction of Semi-Annual Report Regarding SPDES Permit

By letter dated February 22, 1994, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation provided to NRC a semi-annual report on the status of the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station Discharge Permit and any occurrences of noncompliance. Attached to the report were comments from the August 1993 Discharge Monitoring Report. We have determined that certain information contained in those comments is inaccurate. Specifically, the comments indicate that all permit conditions relative to the August 1993 Clam-Trol treatment at Nine Mile Point Unit 2 were met. Based upon our investigation of the matter, we have concluded that detoxifying material was discharged at the conclusion of the Clam-Trol treatment in violation of the conditions of the SPDES Permit. Accordingly, the statement that all permit conditions were met is inaccurate.

While the violation of permit conditions had no significant impact on the environment because of the nature of the detoxifying material, we are nonetheless concerned that a violation of permit conditions occurred. Moreover, we are concerned that the violation was not promptly identified.

The matter currently remains under investigation. At the conclusion of the investigation, we expect to take significant and appropriate corrective actions to address the matter. In the interim, if you have any questions with regard to the permit violation or our actions to address the matter, please feel free to contact me.
