Dear Mr. Tarver:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter dated January 13, 2017, in which you appealed the agency's December 6, 2016, decision related to your November 14, 2016, Freedom of Information Act/Privacy Act (FOIA/PA) request (FOIA/PA-2016-00139). You appealed the denial of information as it related to your FOIA request.

Acting on your appeal, I have reviewed the records in this case and your appeal will be granted per the enclosure. We are releasing the ADAMS numbers assigned to and page count of each weapons safety assessment, Volume 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and template instructions.

This is the final agency decision. As set forth in the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(8)), you can seek judicial review of this decision in a district court of the United States in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business, in the district where the agency's records are situated, or in the District of Columbia.

As part of the 2007 FOIA amendments, the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS) was created to offer mediation services to resolve disputes between FOIA requesters and Federal agencies as a nonexclusive alternative to litigation. Using OGIS services does not affect your right to pursue litigation. If you are requesting access to your own records (which is considered a Privacy Act request), you should know that OGIS does not have the authority to handle requests made under the Privacy Act of 1974.


