This is in reference to your application for a license amendment dated December 15, 2016.

As an RSO you will need a delegation of authority document. I have attached an example from [NUREG-1556 Volume 7, Rev. 1](#). Please have one written and signed by your Certifying Official (Mr. Grant) and please email me a copy at your convenience.

Also, I wanted to mention that you have a fairly large and active program that could present you with some challenges as the RSO. You certainly have many years of safety and management experience. However, I don't know how long ago you had your radiation safety course or how long your current RSO will be sticking around to provide you with technical assistance, which could be significant factors in your comfort with managing the license. I recommend reading through [NUREG-1556 Volume 7, Rev. 1](#) for a refresher. Also, don't forget to read through all your license conditions including reading through the application and letters referenced under the last condition on the license. There is a good appendix on a sample audit program that you can use for your annual program review (see attached).
