15 exercise in exhausting my voice and futility in your trying  
16 to take it all down in a hurry, I think those interested in  
17 it had just best wait a bit. The text will be available.

18 To get the formal part of the proceeding out of  
19 the way, however, I will ask my colleagues to join me in  
20 concurring in the order as drafted.

23 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

24 I think that does the business for now and we can  
25 adjourn this meeting. Those of you who are interested in

1 the papers can get them from Mr. Fouchard.

2 MR. FOUCHARD: I think the final order will take  
3 about an hour.

4 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Thank you.
