RE: Change of Ownership, Sharon Hospital Materials License. (License No. 06-08020-02) *103001272*

To Whom it May Concern:

In accordance with 10 C.F.R. 30.34 and NUREG-1556, please accept this letter as notification that Essent Healthcare of Connecticut, Inc. d/b/a Sharon Hospital, License No. 06-08020-02, is undergoing a possible change of control in connection with the acquisition of substantially all of the assets of Sharon Hospital by Vassar Health Connecticut, Inc. It is expected that the acquisition will be completed during the second quarter of 2017. We have summarized below the information required by NUREG-1556, Sections 5.1 through 5.6:

5.1 Vassar Health Connecticut, Inc. is in the process of purchasing substantially all of the assets of Sharon Hospital. As noted above, it is expected that the purchase will be completed within the second quarter of 2017. A copy of the new organizational chart is attached hereto. Following the acquisition, the name of the licensee will be Vassar Health Connecticut, Inc. d/b/a Sharon Hospital. The name of the Hospital, the mailing address and contact information will remain unchanged.

5.2 No changes in personnel, including the Radiation Safety Officer or licensed users, or duties are expected as a result of the purchase.

5.3 No changes in the location(s) of licensed use, facilities, equipment, or radiation safety procedures are expected as a result of the purchase.


5.4 All required surveillance, including calibrations, leak tests and area surveys, is current and documented.

5.5 In accordance with Condition 13 of License 06-08020-02, Essent Healthcare of Connecticut, Inc. d/b/a Sharon Hospital has restricted the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 C.F.R. 30.35(d) for establishing decommissioning funding assurance. In addition, no decommissioning activities will occur as a result of the purchase. All records concerning decommissioning required to be maintained under 10 C.F.R. Part 30 will continue to be maintained by the Hospital following the change in control. Vassar Health Connecticut, Inc. hereby agrees to maintain any such records previously maintained by and received from the Hospital as required by the applicable NRC regulations.


