This is in reference to your letter dated February 14, 2017, requesting for amendment to Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 47-31438-01, Docket No. 03038439. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

Thank you for performing a survey of the facility located at 4305 First Avenue, Nitro, West Virginia. However, based on the review of the survey instrument, the use of this instrument does not appear that it would meet the release criteria for a facility. NUREG-1757, Volume 1, Revision 2, "Consolidated Decommissioning Guidance Decommissioning Process for Materials Licensees," allows for sealed source licensees to provide the last leak test of all items that were used or stored within the facility to enable the unrestricted release of the facility. Please provide a copy of the latest leak tests for sources that were stored in the 4305 First Avenue, Nitro, West Virginia.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter.
