2 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: If the Commission could come to  
3 order, and if all those crowds will settle down and take their  
4 seats, I have first of all to ask you to join me in voting a  
5 short-notice meeting first on the subject of affirmation of  
6 order regarding issues of TMI-1 restart.

7 I will ask you to join me in voting to hold a meeting  
8 on this affirmation item on less than one week's notice. Those  
9 in favor?

10 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

11 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

12 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

13 So ordered.

14 While we are in a voting mood, let us then also vote  
15 to hold a meeting on less than one week's notice in the matter  
16 of affirmation of the SECY paper 81-173, Motion for Directed  
17 Certification of an Appeal Board Order (In the Matter of Public  
18 Service Company of New Hampshire et al). Those in favor?

19 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

20 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

21 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

22 So ordered.

23 I believe that we are at a place where this can be a  
24 straightforward affirmation session and will not require  
25 discussion of adjudicatory matters. Thus I see no reason to

1 ask you to vote to close the meeting.

2 Sam, would you lead us in the reading of the affirma-  
3 tion?

4 MR. CHILK: The Commission has unanimously approved  
5 an order on TMI restart which has been circulated to you.  
6 Commissioner Bradford, if he were here, would also vote for  
7 this order. Would you please affirm your votes?

8 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

9 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

10 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Aye.

11 So ordered.

12 MR. CHILK: The second one is 81-173, Motion for  
13 Directed Certification of an Appeal Board Order (In the Matter  
14 of Public Service Company of New Hampshire). The Commission  
15 has voted as follows.

16 Commissioner Gilinsky has voted for Option 1 of the  
17 proposed paper. Commissioner Ahearne has voted for Option 1  
18 of the proposed paper. Commissioner Bradford, if he were here,  
19 would be voting for Option 3. The Chairman is recused. He sits  
20 for the purpose of quorum only and votes to abstain. Would you  
21 please affirm your votes?

22 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: I affirm my vote. But as far  
23 as Mr. Bradford's position, I know that he signed the sheet.

24 MR. CHILK: And I have checked out as to whether he  
25 would object to having the affirmation. He had no objection and

1 he does not desire to file a separate appeal.

2 Would you please affirm your votes?

3 COMMISSIONER AHEARNE: Aye.

4 COMMISSIONER GILINSKY: Aye.

5 CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: So ordered.

6 I thank you all very much.

7 (Thereupon, at 2:05 p.m., the meeting was adjourned.)
