Mr. John Saxton,

This notification is to inform you that Strata has confirmed that samples taken from Pond Monitor Well P1-C3 are in exceedance of the limits. This e-mail is a follow up to the phone call made today, March 2, 2017 @ 10:00am.

On February 28, 2017 P1-C3 was sampled and found Chloride to be 24.2 mg/L, which is >20% above the Chloride limit of 19.6 mg/L. Thus requiring that a verification be taken within 24 hours.

Per Strata's Environmental Management Program, Section B.1.5.1 P1-C3 was resampled on March 1, 2017. Sample results found Chloride to be 23.14 mg/L, above the Chloride limit of 19.6 mg/L. and the

Conductivity results found to be 4260 umhos/cm, above the Conductivity limit of 4248 umhos/cm. Thus exceeding the action levels on two parameters, this verification sample confirms that the release criterion is exceeded.

In addition to this notification to you as the NRC Project Manager, all Pond monitor wells are being sampled and will be analyzed for the parameters listed in Strata's Environmental Management Program Section B, Table 5.
