Dear Dr. Agbas:

As we discussed on telephone about your licensed activities regarding NRC License No. 24-32265-01, please provide the following:

- 1) Please provide the current licensed inventory.
- 2) If the licensed material is stored at a location other than the authorized location, please provide a facility diagram.
- 3) You provided that only the RSO has a key to the storage area, please confirm.
- 4) Please provide a commitment that the licensee will not use licensed material until the license be amended.
- 5) As we discussed, you noted that the licensee may transfer the licensed materials to its campus in State of Kansas where the licensee also maintains a radioactive materials license issued by Kansas and will terminate its license with the NRC. Please provide your plan.
- 6) Please provide a commitment that inventory will be conducted at least annually.

Please provide a response in writing with an authorized signature by February 24, 2017. In addition, please indicate Mail Control No. 592575 in the response to facilitate proper mail handling in our office. You can fax your response to 630-515-1078.
