Dear Mr. Tarver:

On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your letter dated February 25, 2017, in which you appealed the agency's January 27, 2017, response related to your January 1, 2017 Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request, FOIA/PA-2017-00286. You appealed the adequacy of search.

Acting on your appeal, I have considered the matter and have determined that there are no records responsive to this request. The Office of the Chief Information Officer's (OCIO) FOIA Office performed a search for responsive records. That office determined that the two persons named in your request are no longer employed at the NRC and therefore there are no records responsive to your request. Therefore, I have denied your appeal.

This is the final agency decision. As set forth in the FOIA (5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(B)), you may seek judicial review of this decision in the district court of the United States in the district in which you reside or have your principal place of business. You may also seek judicial review in the district in which the agency's records are situated or in the District of Columbia.
