Dear Mr. Heiskell:

This concerns the November 17, 2016 letter (ML16341C803), submitted by Todd Hockemeyer, Vice President of Quality & Regulatory Affairs. In that letter, Mr. Hockemeyer requested to list Craig Ogden as an Authorized Nuclear Pharmacist (ANP) on your U.S. NRC License No. 45-25221-05. Via an electronic mail message dated December 20, 2016 (ML17003A028), my colleague – Penny Lansizera, Senior Health Physicist, U.S. NRC Region I, requested additional information concerning Mr. Ogden's training and experience, including recentness of that training, in accordance with Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Section 35.59. In lieu of submitting additional requested information, Mr. Hockemeyer requested to withdraw the amendment request, via letter dated January 31, 2017 (ML17040A039). In accordance with Mr. Hockemeyer's withdrawal letter, we have voided your request. This action is taken without prejudice to the resubmission of your request.

To resubmit your request, please send a signed and dated cover letter, addressed to our office, attention "Materials Licensing Branch," attaching documentation including:

- (1) A letter and/or copy of an unredacted permit from the licensee, Cardinal Health, NRC License No. 34-29200-01, referenced in your November 17, 2016 letter. The letter should confirm the authorizations and dates for which Mr. Ogden was approved as an ANP under that license.
- (2) Documentation showing Mr. Ogden's pharmacist education (i.e. degree, conferring institution, and date completed).
- (3) Documentation showing Mr. Ogden's continuing ANP-related training and experience, completed from 2010 through 2017. (i.e. nuclear pharmacy continuing education credits, hands-on supervised work experience, etc.)


