On behalf of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to the March 7, 2017, letter from you and your colleagues requesting a public meeting on the proposed license transfer and forthcoming revised Post-Shutdown Decommissioning Activities Report for the Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Plant.

The Vermont Nuclear Decommissioning Citizens Advisory Panel (NDCAP) contacted the NRC in early February with a similar request. Working with them, we have agreed to provide the public an opportunity to engage with the NRC on license transfer and decommissioning-related issues through our participation in an NDCAP-sponsored public meeting in the vicinity of Vermont Yankee. We are currently working with NDCAP to identify a suitable meeting date.
