Dear Mr. Gray:

On December 1, 2016, an inspector from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a routine inspection at your facility in Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, with continued in-office review through February 24, 2017. The purpose of the inspection was to review activities performed under your NRC license to ensure that activities were being performed in accordance with NRC requirements. The in-office review included a review of additional information not available during the inspection. Mr. Luis Nieves of my staff conducted a final exit meeting by telephone with you on February 24, 2017, to discuss the inspection findings. This letter and the enclosed non-public Security Addendum (Enclosure 2) present the results of the inspection.

During this inspection, the NRC staff examined activities conducted under your license related to public health and safety. Additionally, the staff examined your compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations as well as the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that violations of NRC requirements occurred. The violations were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at <http://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>. The violations are of a security-related nature. Details of the violations are available in Enclosure 2. The violations are cited in the enclosed, non-public Notice of Violation (Notice) (Enclosure 1). The NRC is citing the violations in the enclosed Notice because the inspector identified them.

You are required to respond to this letter and should follow the instructions specified in the enclosed Notice when preparing your response. The guidance in NRC Information Notice 96-28,

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain Sensitive  
Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information.  
When separated from the Enclosures, this  
transmittal letter is decontrolled.
