Dear Mr. Jackson:

On January 23, 2017, through January 26, 2017, an inspector from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a routine inspection at your Henry Ford Hospital location in Detroit, Michigan, and your Henry Ford Health System Corporate Headquarters location in Detroit, Michigan, with continued in-office review through February 21, 2017. The purpose of the inspection was to review activities performed under your NRC license to ensure that activities were being performed in accordance with NRC requirements. The in-office review included a review of information pertinent to a security-related violation. Mr. Robert Gattone of my staff conducted a final exit meeting by telephone with you on February 21, 2017 to discuss the inspection findings.

During this inspection, the NRC staff examined activities conducted under your license related to public health and safety. Additionally, the staff examined your compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations as well as the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel.

Based on the results of this inspection, the NRC has determined that security-related violations of NRC requirements occurred. The violations were evaluated in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy. The current Enforcement Policy is included on the NRC's website at <http://www.nrc.gov/about-nrc/regulatory/enforcement/enforce-pol.html>. The security-related violations are cited in the enclosed, non-public Notice of Violation (Notice) (Enclosure 1). Details of the security violations are available in the enclosed, non-public Security Addendum (Enclosure 2). The NRC is citing these violations in the enclosed Notice because the inspector identified them.

Enclosures 1 and 2 contain Sensitive
Unclassified Non-Safeguards Information.
When separated from Enclosures 1 and 2,
the transmittal letter is decontrolled.

However, because these issues involve security-related information, Enclosures 1 and 2 to this letter and your response, if you choose to provide one, will not be made available electronically for public inspection. If you do respond, please mark the top of each page with "Security-Related Information – Withhold Under 10 CFR 2.390". To the extent possible, your response should not include any personal privacy, proprietary, or safeguards information.
