General Comment

I am a resident living full time in the San Antonio, TX area. I am writing to strongly OPPOSE this application.

Storage of high level radioactive waste in Texas would require transport of thousands of casks of this material, by train and/or truck, from sites all over the country. San Antonio is included in the major potential transport routes for this material. A potential accident and spill of this material could jeopardize the lives of thousands of citizens. A terrorist diversion/release is also a serious threat. And if a permanent repository ever is developed elsewhere, the transport of all this highly radioactive material would be required a second time.
