Good morning,

Regarding NRC-2016-0231 -- I respectfully ask that the Spent Fuel Storage proposal be turned down. It is too near a vital aquifer, and too near rail lines through major cities (which, as I understand it, would become pass through points for radioactive material on its way to the site).

This creates two major problems:

- 1) If anything were to happen at the storage site, it could contaminate a major source of water for much of the country. There's no going back from that.
- 2) Passing through major metropolitan areas poses a major environmental threat if there were ever an accident on the train, as well as major homeland security threats.
