## General Comment

I strongly oppose Waste Control Specialists' proposed spent nuclear fuel storage facility in West Texas. I am concerned about the potential for contaminating groundwater, particularly the Ogallala aquifer. Transporting this nuclear waste through hundreds of large cities and small communities for temporary storage is far too dangerous. High-level nuclear waste should only be transported once when a deep, underground permanent disposal option becomes available.
