From February 7-9, 2017, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC, or the Commission) conducted a security inspection at the Maryland University Training Reactor Facility. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for your facility.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to security and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspector reviewed selected procedures and records, observation of activities, and interviews with personnel. Based on the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified. No response to this letter is required.
