Dear Mr. Hosfeld:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 30 to the MidMichigan Medical Center – Alpena radioactive materials license, NRC Material License No. 21-17754-01 in accordance with the licensee's January 20, 2017 letter (ML17020A108) requesting to add an authorization for the parenteral administration of any beta emitter, or a photon-emitting radionuclide with a photon energy less than 150 keV as permitted by Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations section 35.300, for Authorized User (AU) Ajay Puri, M.D., who is already authorized for the oral administration of sodium iodide I-131 as permitted by 10 CFR 35.300 on the referenced NRC license.

In addition, we have noted that we have receive a termination request for the referenced license. As we discussed via telephone, due to patient care issues the enclosed license was issued in accordance with your request. However, in accordance with the request, we are transmitting the enclosed amendment to your attention.


