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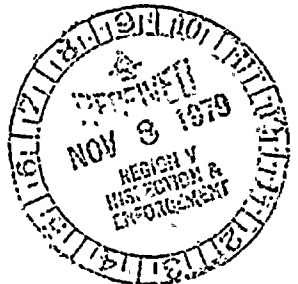

Diablo Canyon Units 1 and 2



Dear Mr. Engelken:

The following information is submitted in response to IE Bulletin 79-24. The bulletin requested that Diablo Canyon be reviewed to determine that adequate protective measures have been taken to assure that safety-related process, instrument and sampling lines do not freeze during extremely cold weather.

The climate at the plant site is mild. A review of the Meteorology data in FSAR Chapter 2.3 (page 2.3-b) shows that the lowest temperature recorded at the plant site to date was 37° F. No lower temperature is to be found in the additional data compiled during the period November 1969 to August 1979 by our Meteorology Department. Therefore, no specific protective measures against freezing have been taken or are necessary at Diablo Canyon.
