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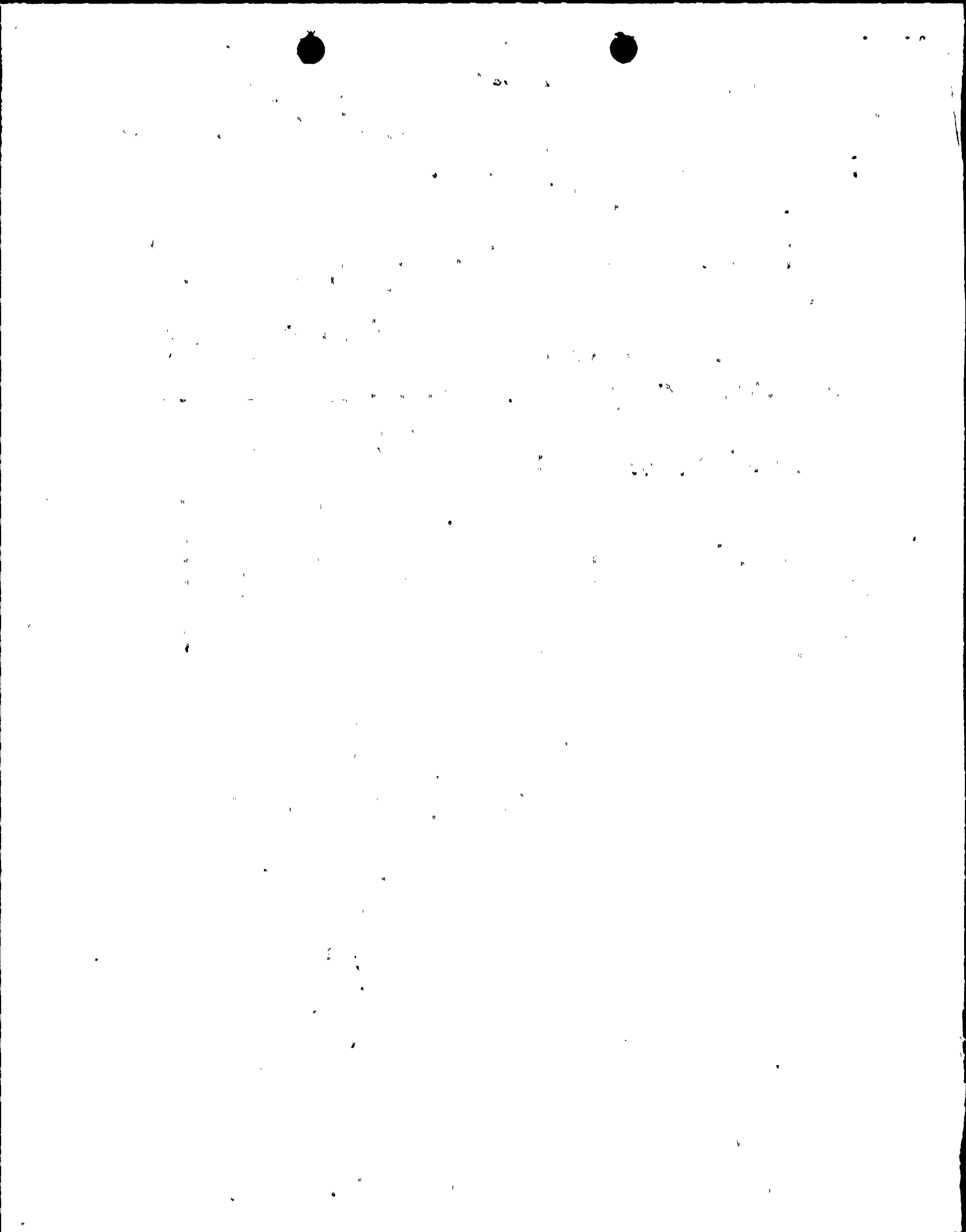
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

Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In July of 1979 we submitted to the NRC Staff a document entitled "Report to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission Describing Response Programs Following the Accident at Three Mile Island." That report presented the results of a study conducted by PGandE immediately following the TMI-2 accident to assess what additional investigations and design modifications were called for in light of the TMI-2 accident. That study was conducted voluntarily by PGandE prior to the issuance of NUREG-0578 and NUREG-0660 by the Staff.

Following the issuance of NUREG-0578 and NUREG-0660, we submitted several responses which addressed the Commission's findings and requirements as set forth in those NUREGs. Those responses culminated in our report dated February 29, 1980 entitled "Response to NUREG-0578: Short Term Lessons Learned Requirements." As stated in the introduction to that report, it is our intention that report be considered to be PGandE's comprehensive response to the TMI-2 incident. As such, all issues addressed in our report of July 1979 have either been superseded by our response to NUREG-0578 and NUREG-0660, or have been resolved. Consequently, there is no need to update the July 1979 report further, or to submit additional status reports on the items contained in that report.
