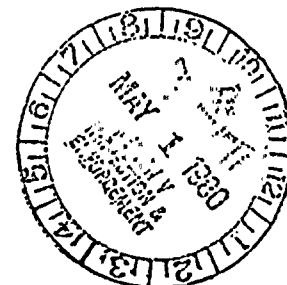

Dear Mr. Engelken:

The following information is provided in response to your IE Bulletin No. 80-04 that requested information relating to the analysis of a main steam line break with continued feed-water addition.

Bulletin No. 80-04 requested:

1. A review of the containment pressure response for potential overpressure with a main steam line break when considering the impact of runout flow from the auxiliary feedwater system.
2. A review of the potential reactivity increase which might result from a main steam line break inside or outside containment.
3. Proposed corrective action and associated schedule if the above reviews indicate a potential for containment overpressure or the reactor return-to-power response worsens.

Reviews pertaining to Items 1 and 2 were performed and the results of these analyses are provided as Attachments 1 and 2.

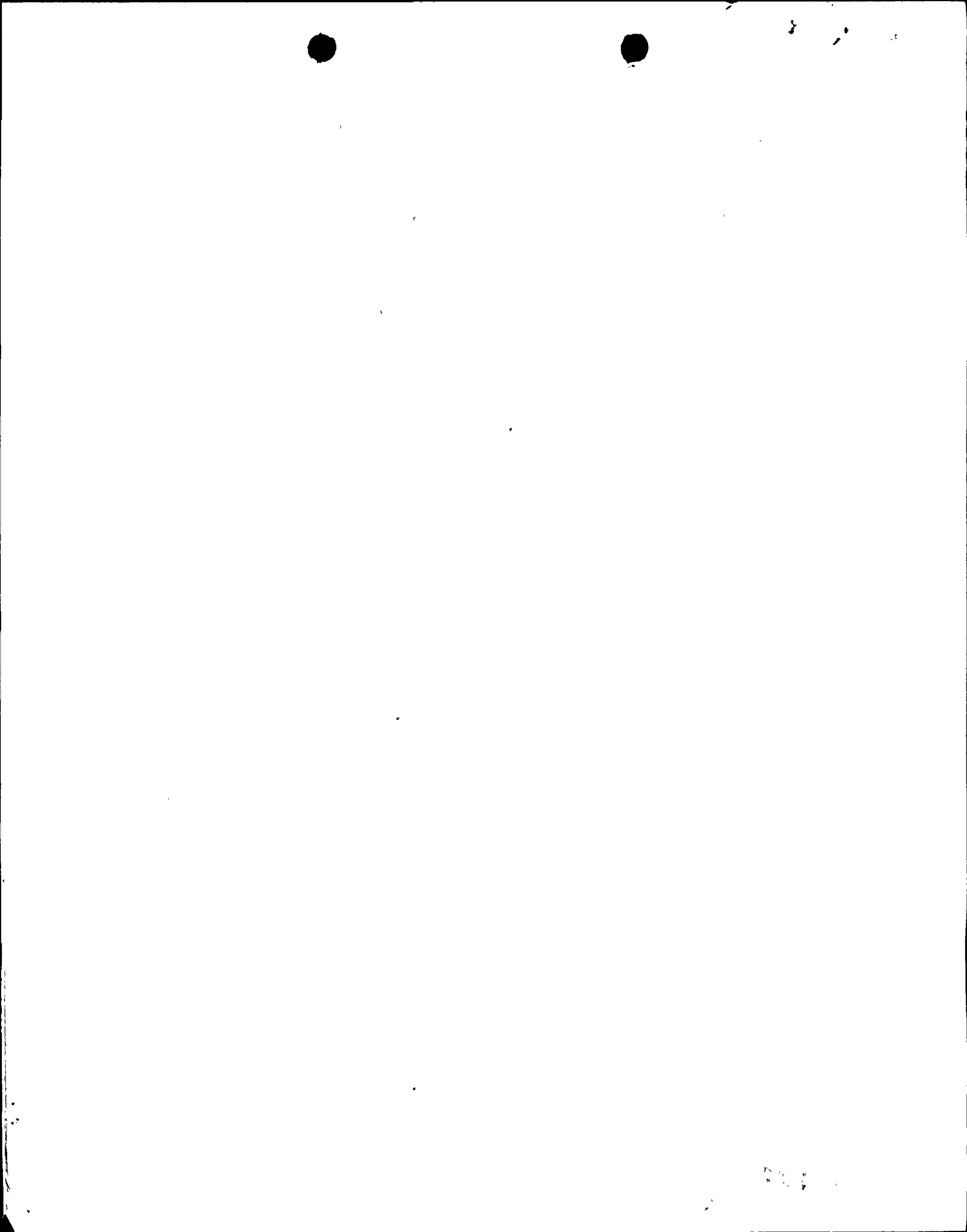


